Tips for Public Wi-Fi Hotspot Security

- 1. **Pick the correct network:** When trying to connect to a public Wi-Fi network, watch for multiple network names that are similar but not the same. Hackers use this tactic, dubbed Wi-Phishing, to try and trick you into logging into the wrong network to get your information.
- 2. **Pick a secure network:** When picking a Wi-Fi hotspot to log into, try and find one that's got you locked out. It's best to stick to hotspots where the provider (hotel, coffee shop, etc) provides you with a password to grant access.
- 3. Ask to connect: Most devices have a setting you can elect that asks you before connecting to a network.
- 4. **Avoid personal data in hotspots:** If possible, avoid doing serious tasks like bill pay, accessing your bank account or using your credit card when connected to public Wi-Fi.
- 5. **Avoid using your passwords:** If you have to enter a password on a public Wi-Fi network use a password manager like LastPass or Dashlane which store passwords for you and keep them encrypted. If you do use passwords without a password manager, make sure you're on sites with a two-factor authentication set up.

This valuable communications tool gives all individuals who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, deaf-blind or having difficulty speaking the opportunity to make personal and business calls just like any other standard telephone user. Both TTY and voice users may initiate calls through Relay Iowa.
